



# SOUTH OSBORNE ROAD WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT UPDATE



## Project Purpose:

The new pipeline will enable WSSC Water's Potomac Water Filtration Plant to enhance water flow and meet the drinking water needs of southern Prince George's County customers while ensuring infrastructure reliability and resiliency.



## Project Status:

WSSC Water contractor, Spinello, is installing 3.66 miles of water main and associated infrastructure along South Osborne Road between Crain Highway and south of William Beanes Road.



## Completed Work:

Spinello has installed 9,900 feet of water mains including:

- An 8-inch diameter water main near Carrol Court
- A 12-inch diameter water main from 7000 South Osborne Road to 7625 Crain Highway (US 301)
- Two miles of 30-inch diameter water main from the intersection of William Beanes Road and South Osborne Road to 7605 South Osborne Road



## Work Remaining:

- Installation of 1/2 mile of 30-inch diameter water main, and associated infrastructure. This installation work will be complete in Summer 2025. Temporary roadway patching will continue during this work.
- After pipe installation is complete, we will plant grass on the disturbed areas and perform permanent roadway patching.
- Final roadway paving, curb to curb, will start in Spring 2025 and finish by late Summer 2025, weather permitting.



## What to Expect:

- Temporary traffic lane closures will remain in effect throughout construction.
- Anticipated work hours are weekdays from 9 am to 3 pm. Work may occasionally extend beyond these hours to complete specific tasks.
